### **Notice of Dissolution of Business Alliance with Japan Post Bank, Co., Ltd.**

We hereby announce that we have agreed with Japan Post Bank Co., Ltd. (hereinafter referred to as "Post Bank") to end the business alliance with Post Bank.

#### Note

1. Reason for the dissolution of business alliance

Since the start of the business alliance between the Bank and Post Bank on May 12, 2008, the Bank, as the principal bank, has consigned Post Bank as an intermediary bank agency for the conclusion of contracts regarding the Bank's personal loan business. As a result of discussions on the business partnership between the two companies, we have reached an agreement to end the partnership, which we believe will contribute to the future of the two companies.

2. Content of the dissolution of the business alliance

Post Bank will terminate the role of intermediary for the conclusion of contracts regarding the Bank's personal loan business (bank agency business). Acceptance of applications for new loans will end on Friday, June 28, 2019 and other details will be discussed by the two companies.
